Seasonal Part-time, \$17.00 - \$18.00 per hour (based on experience)

- Scan their area of responsibility every 10 seconds.
- Supervise pool activities at the aquatics facility and ensures that policies, guidelines, and safety procedures are followed.
- Opens and closes the pool each day according to scheduled hours.
- Assists in cleaning the pool and related facilities and equipment. This includes keeping the pool deck and locker rooms tidy, wiping tables and opening umbrellas, etc.
- Warns swimmers of improper activities or danger and enforces pool regulations and water safety policies.
- Administers first aid in the event of injury, rescues swimmers in distress or danger of drowning, and administers CPR and/or artificial respiration, if necessary.
- Evaluates conditions for safety and initiates aquatics emergency action plan as required.
- Keep accurate records of pool usage, chemical levels, pool closures, etc..
- Maintain a professional appearance and demeanor, including abiding by uniform requirements and upholding our Customer Service expectations.
- Attend all Mandatory Staff Meetings and Trainings.
- Provide excellent customer service daily including welcoming members as they arrive.
- Assist with club and member parties as needed.
- Other duties as assigned throughout the club to ensure smooth daily club operations.
